-  There are cheaper materials on the market such as wire and barbed wire. Have you considered distress and cost of vet bills if your animal gets injured?
-  What type of animal are you fencing? Stallions, mares or other types of stock will have different requirements.
-  Is the topography of area to be fenced suitable?
-  Do streams or creeks need to be crossed?
-  Horses can impact fencing at speed. A well-designed and safe fence may eliminate expensive vet bills and unnecessary stress on the animal. The Bounce Back Fence is designed to flex upon impact.
-  Horses are far-sighted creatures and therefore a highly visible fence is desirable. Bounce Back will assist in protecting your investment for both the animal and infrastructure.
-  Horses will test the strength of a fence.
-  Typically the top rail should be about 1.2m for mares and 1.5m for stallions above ground level and highly visible to the animal.
